Dear Friends in Christ, May your Lenten Season be a reflection of When I called about the change, the food supervisor asked that we also try and get 6 people to prepare the meal at 2:00 p.m. and 14 to serve the meal at 5:15p.m. They are going to begin allowing 30 guests at a time inside the facility for a meal. The other guests will have to take their meals in foam containers. When there is room for another 30, they will be allowed in and so on. This means that those in the dining room will be wiping down chairs as part of their job. Also, all workers are required to wear masks inside the facility.

Please pass this along and let me know by no later than May 15th if you can have volunteers to fill either of these work times. The Angels who put in many hours to make this all happen are in need of a break and if the group can provide some workers, it just makes the whole event easier for all
