ENDOWMENT FUND REPORT: As of March 31, 2022 OSLC's Endowment Fund was \$666,252. Quarterly distributions are made to OSLC from the Fund of part of its earnings. The 1st quarter 2022 payment was \$6,183.60. Purposes for which funds may be used are limited to: Mission, Benevolence; Christian education, and capital building/repairs not budgeted for. The Council directed the following payments at its last meeting: \$1000 to SD Synod for mission work; \$750 to Moody Co. breadbasket; \$750 to Moody Co. Boys & Girls Club; \$750 to summer rec scholarships; \$2000 to capital outlay for future OSLC needs; the balance to carry over to be designated in the future.
