ENDOWMENT FUND REPORT: As of January 1, 2021 OSLC's Endowment Fund value was \$624,972.09. OSLC continues to receive about \$5000 per quarter from fund earnings. Our bylaws provide for funds to be used for four purposes: mission work; benevolence; Christian education; and capital building/repairs that are not budgeted for. The council has directed payments from distributions each quarter unless changed as follows: \$1000 to SD Synod for mission work in Cameroon and Nicaragua; \$1000 to Flandreau Breadbasket; \$2000 to be set aside for capital building/repair needs; balance to be retained. In addition, a one-time donation of \$1000 to the Nicaragua Lutheran Church for hurricane relief was made.
