Personal Care Kits:

- 1 light/mid-weight bath towel maximum 52"X 27", dark color recommended
- 2 bath size bar (4-5 oz) of soap, any brand, in its original wrapping
- 1 adult-size toothbrush in its original wrapping
- 1 sturdy comb, remove packaging
- 1 nail clippers, remove packaging

****** All items should be new and in good condition. Wrap smaller items in the towel and tie with a ribbon or yarn.

Soap: LWR accepts new bars of any brand soap, in their original wrapping. All bar sizes are accepted; however, bath-size bars (4-5 oz) are highly preferred.
