OSLC's BETHEL BOARD of DIRECTORS position will need to be filled at our 2021 Annual Meeting. The Bethel Board meets the 4th Monday of each month. The Board is comprised of an Executive Committee, Building Committee, Finance Committee, and Policy Committee. The board members listen to things related to the operation of Bethel, make recommendations and vote on matters that relate to the building, financials, and policies. OSLC is a part owner of Bethel, so it is important we have representation on the board. Linda Meier has served her 2 consecutive terms on the board, and like other outgoing board members, has stated her experience was rewarding and helped give a better understanding on the operations of nursing homes. ENDOWMENT FUND REPORT: As of August 31, 2021 OSLC's Endowment Fund value was \$675,960.23. To that was added \$20,000 received as a donation from Jim Suhr's family in his memory. Quarterly distributions are made to OSLC from the Fund of part of its earnings. The third quarter payment was \$5576.54. Purposes for which funds may be used are limited to: Mission, Benevolence; Christian education, and capital building/repairs not budgeted for. The Council directed the following payments at its last meeting: \$1000 to SD Synod for mission work; \$1000 to local breadbasket; \$2000 to capital outlay for future needs; the balance to its Education/Benevolence fund, and from that fund, to donate \$2000 to Helping Kids Round First. 10/28/2021
