#### OSLC WELCA CHRISTMAS POTLUCK AND MEETING MINUTES

The event was held on Thursday December 8, 2022.

Gwen Gullickson reported that all quilt donations, and the number of kits that were put together will be in the 2022 annual report of OSLC. It was decided that the amounts for disbursement and the agencies to receive them will remain the same as last year. It was also decided to set up a contingency fund using some of the money from the Love

offering that could be used to help people out in an emergency. This will be coordinated by the pastor and the current WELCA treasurer. Circle Bible study will begin in January. All circles will meet together on the 3rd Thursday of each month at 10:30. Pastor Ramona will lead the study when possible, using the Bible study from the Gather Magazine. 2023 WELCA meetings will be held as needed after the Bible Study. This will be announced in the Happenings. WELCA booklets will be done the same as last year. Copies will be available for everyone to pick up after church or from the office starting in January. New members will be added when they join OSLC and will receive a copy of the booklet at that time. No Riverview communion visits are scheduled at this time but Pastor Ramona will check on resuming the monthly service and on individual visits with residents.

<u>THE BREADBASKET</u> has a theme based suggestion list for every month. All regular food and monetary donations are still happily accepted.

**February:** (Easter dinner supplies for April 17th) instant potatoes, canned cranberry jelly, canned pumpkin, green beans, cream of mushroom soup, crispy fried onions, corn, stuffing, canned sweet potatoes, marshmallows, and baking supplies, etc.

If you are in need of food, bring your photo ID and official piece of mail. Open Thursdays from 1:30-5pm. Located at 202 E 2nd Ave. Flandreau. You can receive food once a month.

MOODY COUNTY CARES: The Moody County Ministerial Association and Moody County Cares are working together along with the Breadbasket, Maynard's, and others to coordinate a response to the needs for food and other essentials by the people of Moody County. This effort will serve two groups of people: those who can't afford needed items such as food, soap, and laundry detergent, and those who can afford needed items but need to stay isolated for health reasons (seniors, immunocompromised, etc).
