OLSC ENDOWMENT FUND REPORT: As of March 31, 2023, OSLC's Endowment Fund value was \$609,168; an increase from \$586,000 on January 1. Quarterly distributions are made to OSLC from the fund of part of its earnings. At the end of March, \$6,166 was received for the first quarter of 2023 and approximately that amount is expected to be received at the end of each quarter. Uses of these funds are limited to: Mission, Benevolence, Christian education, and capital building/repairs not budgeted for. The Endowment Committee met last month and recommended the Council use funds received this year for the following: \$1,000/quarter to the SD Companion Synod for mission work; \$750/quarter to Moody County Breadbasket; \$750/quarter to Moody County Boys and Girls Club; \$2,000/quarter set aside for OSLC improvements/repairs and the balance (\$1,666 this quarter) to be used in the discretion of the Council for any of the authorized purposes as needs are identified

From the Bishop's Desk: Dear SD Synod,

Grace and peace to you in the name of our risen Lord and Savior, Jesus the Christ!

We are people of the Resurrection: "Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God." (Colossians 3:1) What does that mean to you? What do you hear when you hear those words about being raised with Christ? What are the things above that we should set our hearts on?

As people of the Resurrection, we are people that walk wet, not because of the snow and rain we are having this Spring, but because of our baptismal promises. We continuously live in the tension of 'both and' as Lutherans. We are sinners and fall short of the glory of God. All. The. Time. AND we are saints, set free through the gift of Christ's resurrection to live a life free of fear. How would your life change if you would be completely set free of your fears? How would your congregation's climate and life change, if you would be set free of all fears?
