WELCA MEETING SUMMARY: for Thursday July 20, 2023 There is \$2540 in the WELCA checking account as of 7-20-23. Bills to be paid for supplies in the kitchen will bring the balance to approximately \$2400. \$1,125 was received for the Love offering. \$217 was dispersed to each of the local charities on the WELCA list. Items for school kits are now being gathered. The list of supplies needed is in the Happenings. WELCA has served 5 funerals so far in 2023. Pastor Ramona reported that the Ministerial Association is getting started up agin. The contingency fund WELCA had set up for those in need of assistance has not been used. It was decided to give that amount of the contingency fund to the Ministerial Association for this year only. The WELCA Treasurer will look up the exact amount. Pastor is going to Riverview and Edgewood once a month for visitation. Helpers from the Circles are not need to go with her at this time. Guest Day is set for Sept. 14, 2023 starting at noon. All women from the area will be invited to the salad luncheon. The fall gathering for Medary Conference WELCA will be on Sept 19, 2023 in Arlington. OSLC WELCA will host the spring gathering in Flandreau on April 24, 2024.

## EVER WONDER WHAT THE SOUTH DAKOTA SYNOD DOES?

At the 2023 synod assembly, we learned that "Journeying Together in Christ" as the South Dakota Synod, in 2022 we:

- Walked a new start congregation, Spirit of Hope, in Scotland, South Dakota, as they called their mission developer and found a site to worship, after outgrowing the house they were worshipping in.
- Continued to partner with the McLaughlin Community Alliance Group, a nonprofit utilizing the building of Redeemer Lutheran Church for the empowerment of the community.
- Began exploration for two new potential church plants, with Box Elder and Shepherd's Table in Sioux Falls.
- Walked with 30 people in various stages of candidacy and had three new entrance interviews in January of 2023.
- Received nine new first call candidates, completed 28 ministry site studies and extended 41 calls. Insured that nearly every congregation has a called pastor, interim pastor, synodically authorized minister, or lay leader to care for God's people.
- Distributed \$60,201 through the seminary debt reduction program, granted \$124,290 in scholarship funds to seminary students plus \$20,000 in internship site assistance.
- Distributed 37 disaster recovery micro grants for \$18,800 to congregations in need of repairs or community relief after natural disasters. In addition, Beaver valley Lutheran Church received \$22,000 from Lutheran disaster response and \$10,000 from Synod storm recovery funds for their tornado recovery.
- Continued to invest in developing our rostered leaders, synodically authorized leaders, and lay leaders through a variety of new education initiatives.
- Created new synod staff positions including a rural ministry liaison to journey with our rural ministry sites. The rural ministry liaison has worked with congregations in transition all across South Dakota.
