OLSC ENDOWMENT FUND REPORT: OSLC's Endowment Fund value was \$623,135 on June 1. Part of the Fund's earnings is distributed to OSLC each quarter. In April, and again July, \$6,166 was received. A similar amount is expected at the end of each of the last two quarters. These funds are used for mission, benevolence, Christian ed., and unbudgeted capital building/ repairs. The council distributed funds received this year for the following: \$1,000/qtr. to the SD Companion Synod for mission work, \$750/qtr. to Moody County Breadbasket, \$750/quarter to Moody County Boys & Girls Club, \$2,000/qtr. set aside for OSLC improvements/repairs, and the balance for local community needs including: summer rec/pool scholarships, Weekend Fuel (weekend meals for students), Liberty's Troops (help for families of children with serious illnesses), and Fliers Closet (clothing/ hygiene products for students).

THANK YOU, OUR SAVIORS LUTHERAN. Because of your work and the work of Messiah Lutheran, 363,000 meals are on the way to Sudan refugee camps in Africa; where a Civil War has erupted.

During Covid, 2 containers of food were packed, 10-15-20 people (a) a time. Mostly Lutherans. That work led to hundreds of thousands of meals being gifted per year to the non profit. This will not be the last food sent to refugees in Africa. More is already committed
